How do I get French citizenship?

Verified 29 August 2022 - Legal and Administrative Information Directorate (Prime Minister)

There are 2 main ways to obtain French nationality: the declaration of nationality and naturalisation.

The declaration concerns you married or if you have relationship with a french person (descendant, brother or sister...).

The naturalisation is subject to several conditions, in particular length of residence in France.

Special rules apply if you were born in France to foreigners parents.

Finally, you can become French again if you lost French nationality.

The approach varies according to you born abroad or in France.

You were born abroad

You have been a foreign national since birth

You live in France

You can become French by declaration if you married or have relationship with French person :

Your spouse is French (https://www.service-public.fr/particuliers/vosdroits/F2726? lang=en)

You have a French child or grandchild (https://www.service-public.fr/particuliers/vosdroits/F33430? lang=en)

You have a French brother or sister (https://www.service-public.fr/particuliers/vosdroits/F33800? lang=en)

You were lang=en)

by a French person.

or

You can become French by naturalisation, under conditions, if you are in one of the following situations:

You have been living in France 5 years or older

You have refugee status

You come from a French and you speak french because it's your mother tongue

You come from a French-speaking country and have been educated 5 years or more in a French-language institution

You served in the French army

You joined the French army or an allied army in time of war

You have rendered exceptional services to France

You have graduated from a French higher education institution after 2 years of study

You can make (or have made) important services to France based on your abilities and talents

You have completed an exceptional integration journey (activities or actions carried out in the civic, scientific, economic, cultural or sports fields...)

If you are in one of these situations, you canmake lang=en)

Exceptionally, French nationality may be granted to you:

On the proposal of the Minister of Defence, if you were injured during your engagement in the French army

On the proposal of the Minister of Foreign Affairs, if you are French-speaking and that you contribute by your activity to the influence of France.(https://www.service-public.fr/particuliers/vosdroits/F15830? lang=en)

If you are in another situation, contact naturalisation platform that depends on place where you live.

You live abroad

You can become French by naturalisation, under conditions, if you are in one of the following situations:

You work for the French State or an organisation whose activity is of particular interest for the French economy or culture

You stay in Monaco

You do your national service or are engaged in regular training of the French army

You are a national volunteer

You were born in France

If you born in France to foreigners parents, you can become French by making declaration the court or the local court.
